

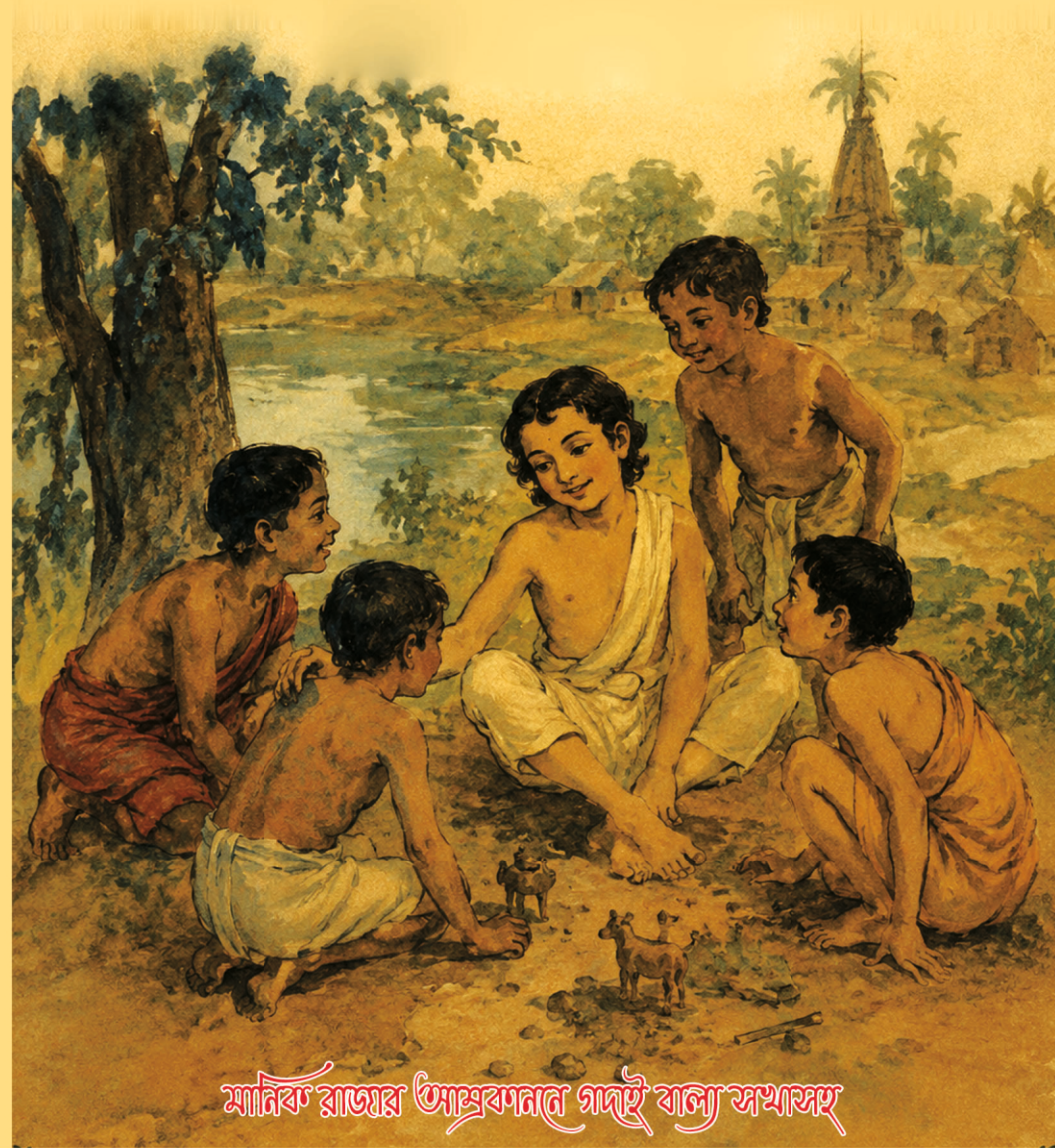

Origination of Baranagar Math

The Baranagar Math is the forerunner of later Ramakrishna Math. The name 'Ramakrishna Math' was, however, totally unknown to the devotees and others. The name 'Baranagar Math' was well-known. In the letters of the Holy Mother, Swamiji and his brother-disciples, the address was always stated to be 'Baranagar Math'. In the middle of 1897 or afterwards the Math got the name 'Ramakrishna Math'. For its foundation Baranagar Math had a strong spiritual current. In the face of this current Swamiji and his brother-disciples ignored misery, poverty, calumny, oppression, want of food, disease and the like. The way Swamiji and his brother-disciples lived in the Baranagar monastery, their days of unparalleled austerity, their spiritual practices, renunciation and dispassion will remain written in letters of gold in the history of the Ramakrishna Order. All these formed the cornerstone of the order and the **Baranagar Math** was built on this solid foundation.

বরানগর মঠ (১৮৮৬-১৮৯২) : এক জ্যোতিস্তম্ভ

শ্রীরামকৃষ্ণদেবের মর্ত্যলীলা সংবরণের পর নরেন্দ্রনাথ (পরবর্তীকালে স্বামী বিবেকানন্দ) এবং তাঁর গুরুভাইরা গৃহত্যাগ করে বরানগরের এই জীর্ণ পরিত্যক্ত বাড়ীটিতে ১৮৮৬ সালে আশ্রয় গ্রহণ করেছিলেন। পাঁচ বছরের কিছু বেশী সময় তাঁরা এখানে বাস করেছিলেন। সাধারণের পক্ষে অবর্ণনীয় তীব্র আর্থিক অনটন এবং জীবনধারণের জন্য ন্যূনতম প্রয়োজনীয় বিষয়ের প্রচণ্ড অভাব উপেক্ষা করে তাঁরা চরম কঠোরতা এবং বৈরাগ্য অবলম্বনে জপ-ধ্যান, পূজার্চনা এবং অন্যান্য বিবিধ প্রকার তপস্যায় একেবারে ডুবে গিয়েছিলেন। এই সময়ের স্মৃতিচারণ করে পরবর্তীকালে স্বামীজী বলেছেন, “ঠাকুরের দেহ যাবার পর আমরা বরানগর মঠে কত জপ-ধ্যান করতুম। সে কঠোরতা দেখলে ভূত পালিয়ে যেত, মানুষের কথা কি!”

এভাবেই স্বামীজীর নেতৃত্বে রামকৃষ্ণ সঙ্ঘের প্রথম মঠের সূচনা হল। এই সেই পবিত্র ভূমি – যেখানে স্বামীজী এবং তাঁর গুরুভাইরা মানবসেবায় জীবন উৎসর্গের উদ্দেশ্যে সন্ন্যাস গ্রহণ করেছিলেন।

তৎকালের বরানগর মঠ বর্তমানে রামকৃষ্ণ মঠ, বরানগর নামে সুপরিচিত।



আমাদের কথা

রামকৃষ্ণ মঠ, বরানগর (পূর্বতন বরানগর মঠ) এখন যেখানে অবস্থিত সেখানেই প্রায় ২একর জমির উপর ভাড়া নেওয়া এক জীর্ণ, পরিত্যক্ত বাগানবাড়ীতে স্বামী বিবেকানন্দ ১৮৮৬ সালে রামকৃষ্ণ সংঘের প্রতিষ্ঠা করেন। এখানেই স্বামী বিবেকানন্দ ও তাঁর গুরুভাইরা পাঁচ বছরেরও (১৮৮৬ - ১৮৯২) বেশী সময় দৃষ্টির তপস্যা করেন। স্বামীজী এবং তাঁর গুরুভাইদের সন্ন্যাস গ্রহণও এই পূণ্য ভূমিতেই অনুষ্ঠিত হয়েছিল। এখান থেকেই স্বামীজীর ঐতিহাসিক ভারত পরিক্রমার সূচনা। পরিক্রমা সমাপনান্তে তাঁর ভক্ত এবং গুণগ্রাহীদের অর্থানুকূল্যে তিনি আমেরিকার শিকাগো শহরে আয়োজিত “বিশ্ব ধর্ম মহাসম্মেলন”-এ যোগদান করে বিশ্বের দরবারে রামকৃষ্ণ ভাবধারাকে সুপ্রতিষ্ঠিত করেন। তারই ফলস্বরূপ বেলেডুমঠ এবং তার দেশ-বিদেশের ২৯১টি শাখা কেন্দ্রের ক্রমবিকাশশীল বর্তমান রূপ।

রামকৃষ্ণ সংঘের এই অপ্রতিরোধ্য অগ্রগতির সঙ্গে সাযুজ্য রক্ষা করা সংঘের এই আদি কেন্দ্রটির পক্ষে এক দূরূহ বিষয় হয়ে দাঁড়িয়েছে আর্থিক অসঙ্গতির কারণে। ক্রমবর্ধমান চাহিদার কারণে সামাজিক এবং আর্থিকভাবে পিছিয়ে পড়া পরিবারের শিশুদের অপ্রচলিত শিক্ষা ব্যবস্থার মাধ্যমে শিক্ষিত করে তোলার উদ্দেশ্যে মঠ পরিচালিত বড়াল পাড়াস্থ ‘গদাধর শিশু বিকাশ কেন্দ্রে’ স্থানাভাবের জন্য রতনবাবু রোডে নতুন ছয়তলা (গ্রাউন্ড ফ্লোর সমেত) বিদ্যালয় ভবনের নির্মাণ কাজ চলছে। অন্য দিকে, ভক্ত সাধারণের স্মৃতিচারণায় সহায়তার উদ্দেশ্যে শ্রীরামকৃষ্ণ পার্শ্বদেবের ত্যাগ, তপস্যা ও কৃচ্ছ সাধন এখানে যে জীর্ণ বাড়ীতে হয়েছিল তার একটি প্রতিকল্প (Replica Building) নির্মাণ করার পরিকল্পনা করা হয়েছে। মঠ প্রাঙ্গণের দক্ষিণ-পূর্ব কোণের প্রায় সাড়ে ছয় কাঠা জমি এই নির্মাণ প্রকল্পে অন্তর্ভুক্ত করা হয়েছে। কিন্তু এই প্রকল্পের প্রারম্ভিক কাজ শুরু করার মতো আর্থিক অবস্থায় আমরা এখনও পৌঁছাতে পারিনি।

২০২৫-২৬ আর্থিক বছরে শ্রীশ্রীমায়ের তিথি পূজায় তিনদিন ব্যাপী উৎসবে ভক্ত সম্মেলন ও যুব সম্মেলনের সঙ্গে বিভিন্ন ধরনের সাংস্কৃতিক অনুষ্ঠান, যার মধ্যে গদাধর শিশু বিকাশ কেন্দ্রের প্রাতঃকালীন বিভাগের নাটক ‘লোকমাতা রাণী রাসমণি’ এবং দিবা-কালীন বিভাগের ‘সত্যানুসন্ধান স্বামীজী’ বিশেষ উল্লেখের দাবী রাখে। বিভিন্ন সন্ন্যাসী এবং বিদগ্ধ জনের মনোগ্রাহী আলোচনা শ্রোতাদের হৃদয় স্পর্শ করেছে। ভগবান শ্রীরামকৃষ্ণের আবির্ভাব তিথি উপলক্ষ্যে স্থানীয় নাট্যসংস্থা ‘ইচ্ছেডানা’ প্রযোজিত গিরিশচন্দ্রের জীবনী সম্বলিত নাটক ‘পাঁচ সিকে পাঁচ আনা’ দর্শকদের অভিনন্দন লাভ করে।

OUR MISSION AND VISION

Swami Vivekananda established the monastic order in an isolated dilapidated haunted garden house over the present site of Baranagar Math in the year 1886. Here Swamiji and other monastic disciples of Sri Ramakrishna passed more than 5 years (1886 - 1892) practicing unprecedented “Tapasya” following penury and privation to focus entirely on meditation, study, and penance for self-realization and service to the mankind. They laid the foundational energy for the global Ramakrishna movement solidifying the realization of harmony and equal validity of all religions. As of today there has been expansion of Ramakrishna Math and Ramakrishna Mission branch centres to 291 all over the globe.

At Baranagar Math, in the financial year 2025-26 the development of various welfare activities has been increased substantially. As a result, the requirement of more fund has become absolutely necessary. The construction of the new G+5 storied school building is in progress; on the other hand the initiative for construction of the replica building of Baranagar Math has been undertaken for preserving the spiritual significance of Old Baranagar Math. First of all, the construction of the new school building is to be completed over the site at 28A/6, Ratan Babu Road within December 2026. The students of our existing school building are very much enthusiastic for shifting of their school premises to the new specious building. To start the work for replica building over the site of Baranagar Math a new land measuring 6.5 cottahs has been purchased in the meantime. Although a few Govt. Departments, patrons have given some donations to carry out the above two important projects, there is the requirement of more fund for its completion.

In the year 2025-26 on the occasion of Tithi Puja of Sri Sri Maa, the grand celebration programme was continued for 3 days including Youth Conference, Devotees’ Conference and Cultural Functions. The most remarkable functions were the presentations of drama - ‘*Lokmata Rani Rashmoni*’ by the students of Morning Section and ‘*Satyānu-Sandhāne Swamiji*’ by the students of Day Section of Gadadhar Sishu Vikas Kendra which were much appreciated by the Sannyasins and the audience. Again on the occasion of Tithi Puja of Sri Ramakrishna, the local drama club ‘*Icche Dānā*’ presented one famous drama named - ‘*Pānch Sike Pānch Annā*’ which was also acclaimed by the audience expressing high opinion of the drama and the acting part.

On the other hand, various types of spiritual services like initiations, daily programme on reading and discussions on spiritual scriptures throughout the year, Sri Sri Durga Puja, Sri Sri Kali Puja, Sri Sri Sodahsi Puja (on the night of *Falaharini Kali Puja*), Shivaratri Puja, Janmastami, Ramnavami etc. have been observed grandiosely. Other developmental programmes like health, relief and the human resources development etc. also continued successfully.

We wish the wellbeing of all the devotees and patrons and pray to Sri Sri Thakur, Sri Sri Ma and Swamiji Maharaj to bestow their blessings upon all! The hearty co-operation of all the devotees and patrons is earnestly solicited to continue the progress of the welfare and developmental services.

Religio-Cultural Performances

In this year the celebration of Holy Mother's Tithi Puja was held for three days covering the programmes like Bhakta and Yuva Sammelan, Christmas Eve, etc. Among the speakers in the programmes were Srimat Swami Suviranandaji Maharaj, Srimat Swami Viswanathanandaji Maharaj, Swami Shivapradananda, Swami Ishteshananda, Swami Santipradananda, Sri Swaraj Mazumder, Prof. Goutam Mukhopadhyay, Prof. Arijit Sarkar, Sri Sanjay Mukhopadhyay and others.

Services for the Community Development

Other service activities of this centre include the (i) free medical care facilities for all (ii) daily milk feeding programme to the poor - aged, and children through distribution of Milk, Bread, cake, banana, apple, guava, etc. (iii) monthly monetary help to the old and crippled (iv) payment of monthly scholarship to the poor and needy students to help cover educational expenses (v) distribution of new clothes - Saree and Dhoti and blankets to the local poor people as well as to the people living in the remote areas in the districts like North - 24 Parganas (Sundarban Area), Bankura (Hijaldihia, Borjora) etc. The demand for the humane service is increasing progressively.

Students attractive Performances

Following the guidance of Ramakrishna Math and Ramakrishna Mission, Belur Math, Headquarters, the grand festival - 'Kolkata Pratyavartan Diwas Celebration', commemorating Swamiji's return to Kolkata on Feb 19, 1897 after visiting China, Japan and the USA, was observed by Baranagar Math on 19 February, 2026. In this Programme the students of both the units of GSVK participated in the 'Colourful Parade' with the musical instruments such as beat drums, kettledrum, bugle, clarinet as well as hand percussion instruments in the Guard of Honour parade.

The dream Project on construction of a Replica Building of old Baranagar Monastery – a special initiative

A brief history of Baranagar Math



Baranagar Math (1886 - 1892)
The First Monastery of Ramakrishna Order

After Mahasamadhi of Sri Ramakrishna, Narendranath (later Swami Vivekananda) founded Ramakrishna Sangha at a dilapidated haunted garden house at Baranagar in the later part of the year 1886. The first Monastic Order of the Sangha then started at the place which was named Baranagar Math. Narendranath and fourteen other disciples of Sri Ramakrishna started to live in this deserted broken house in 1886. They used to undergo deep meditation (*tapasya*) every day braving

unprecedented penury and privation collecting daily food by 'Holy begging' (*Mādhukari*) for survival. In January 1887 Narendranath Datta and nine others performed '*Virajā Homā*' at this place and took the formal vow of '*sanyasa*' to dedicate their lives for the welfare of mankind following blazing zeal of renunciation and service to the mankind.

What happened aftermath :-

After Swamiji and others had left this holy place, the dilapidated old Baranagar Math building unfortunately crumbled to dust. The land of the garden house had changed its hand and many buildings, shops and slums sprang up there in course of time.

Later after about 112 years, Ramakrishna Math & Ramakrishna Mission started a new center at this place in the year 2004 securing a small portion of the land. The garden house, taken on rent by Narendranath at Rs.11/- per month, was there covering an area of about 02 acres. After a small area of land was possessed by Ramakrishna Math & Ramakrishna Mission, the main initiative was taken to recover the total area of 02 acres of land and within this period more than 01 acres has been recovered and the persuasion is going on for restoration of the entire land of old Baranagar Math's monastery area.

The Project :-

The most exciting information that will please everyone is to announce that the exact area of the land where the historical building was located has been earmarked for Replica Building Construction and the new construction is to be started keeping the same base brick structure to build the Replica Building displaying the accurate copy of the monument similar and close reproduction of the original work of art. The edifice to be constructed for the purpose of religious submission and humble worship of the devotees in commemoration of the days of Swamiji and His cohorts' great sacrifice of their lives for the holy purpose of attaining spiritual perfection. In future it will be a place of international pilgrimage for visiting the '*Tapobhumi*' of the great disciples of Sri Ramakrishna. Also the programme for setting up one

museum along with the Animation Profile pictures of all the monastic brothers will be placed to describe their daily chores which they had to follow in course of their living at this place.

The proposed Replica Building will combine various architectural features of monuments as it has been described by Swami Virajanandaji Maharaj who was the first person to join the Ramakrishna Order at Baranagar Math and seen the building himself, and other information received from reliable sources. The building would be constructed by the competent authority like M/s. Larsen & Toubro who are experienced in this type of work. It is therefore, proposed that the project to be given to M/s. Tata Projects Ltd. for their planning of construction work over 02 acres of the land so as to bring about all-round development of the place as well as the development of the public for their physical, mental, emotional, intellectual and spiritual uplifting. At this stage the total cost for implementation of the dream project cannot be estimated but it is assumed that a few crores of rupees to be needed for this purpose. People coming from different parts of India as well as from overseas countries, usually express interest to see the building of the old Baranagar Math which is not in existence now but the pictures of the old building are there which is shown to the devotees. As a mark of commemoration, two main gate-pillar stand tall which we show to the visitors at present. Under this situation the construction of the Replica Building is very much needed for satisfaction of the eagerly devotees. And all possible care to be taken to construct the Replica Building maintaining the specific features of the old Baranagar Math for rousing devotion of the visitors to this holy site, once resided by Swami Vivekananda along with the fourteen apostles of Sri Ramakrishna.

May the Memorial stand eternal as witness of sacrifice and unity of all to help spiritual regeneration !

Dear Patron,

The project on imparting education to the slum children living around Baranagar Math is going most successfully for the last 21 years. Presently, there are 421 students in our school. The number of the Teachers and the Attendants are 24 and 4 respectively. The students are given text books, exercise books, uniforms, daily tiffin etc. at free of cost. The school has earned a good reputation in the region and the passed-out students are getting admissions in different reputed high schools of North Kolkata.

The yearly expenditure per student has been increased substantially. More over in the 2025-26 no sponsoring support was received for 125 students.

Under this situation, to mitigate the financial problem and running the project successfully, we had no other way but to increase the rate of yearly donation for this purpose to **Rs.12,000/- (twelve thousand) per year per student for the donors.** The donors who have been supporting more than one student may take instalment-advantage, if they like to do so.

The new donors who like to join the scheme are requested to donate Rs.12,000/- per student for the year 2026-27.

Dear Patron,

For over a decade the poor students living in the surrounding areas of Ramakrishna Math, Baranagar are being helped through disbursing of scholarships for their studies in the secondary or higher level education to be independent and self-supporting to earn their livelihood. Severe poverty has been their birth-companion who are destined to be labourer or housemaid or problem-children of the society. Ramakrishna Math, Baranagar has taken up initiative to keep an eye on the students who are really interested to continue their studies. Already many Scholarship recipients, both boys and girls, have come up successful in their life and have been able to raise standard of living of their families, which they never dreamt of. Some students had already secured good jobs in the reputed companies.

The present group of 31 students have been enjoying scholarship support through this Centre. Under this project each of the students is being given Rs.15,000/- per year which is being credited to his/ her bank account on monthly basis. Through our observation it is felt that the higher-class students need more scholarship amount which would help them to meet their increased expenses for studies.

It has, therefore, been decided to increase the rate of yearly donation for this purpose to **Rs.15,000/- per student per year.**

We hope, you would kindly bear with us to join in this noble programme on education for the youths as desired by Swami Vivekananda, the Social Reformer, Philosopher and Great Thinker.
